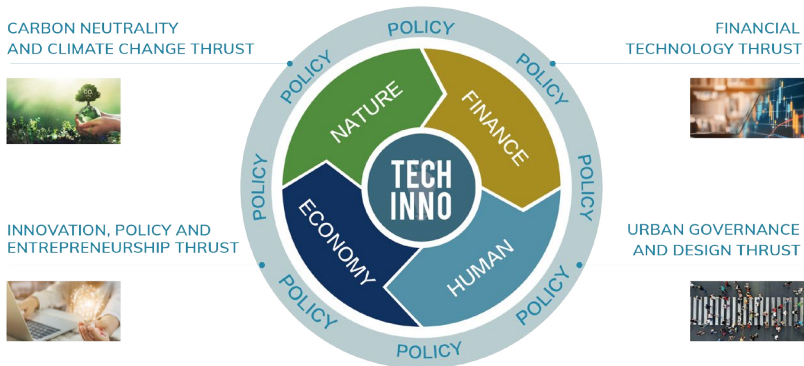

MPhil Master of Philosophy in Carbon Neutrality and Climate Change*

PhD Doctor of Philosophy in Carbon Neutrality and Climate Change

The MPhil/PhD program in Carbon Neutrality and Climate Change will offer specialized training to tackle and adapt to the challenges of climate change that arise due to the transition towards a low-carbon society. The energy transition calls for a comprehensive array of transformations that requires deep integration of AI+ science and engineering, social science and humanities, to create intelligent and innovative solutions. This huge change will have far-reaching implications for many areas over the coming decades. We seek to educate students and provide them with state-of-the-art knowledge and comprehension of carbon neutrality and how it relates to finance, policy and AI+ environmental science.

The program focuses on in-depth integration of multiple fields of humanities and social science with AI+ science and engineering. The course design emphasizes an interdisciplinary approach, which covers key areas such as low-carbon technologies, carbon neutrality economics and policies, green investment and financial strategies, and the integration of AI+ technologies. It aims to cultivate urgently needed, highly skilled, versatile talent who are competent in “dual carbon” work and can lead industry development. The program focuses on advanced research with an aim to place graduates in academia, research institutes, and industrial jobs that appreciate research capability and quality.

This MPhil/PhD program will furnish students with project-based training to prepare them for inclusion in an exclusive cohort of carbon and engineering professionals equipped with work readiness skills and a comprehension of the low-carbon economy. The program’s credentials are comparable to those of MPhil/PhD programs offered by leading universities in Europe and the United States.

This MPhil/PhD program will be the first of its kind in Asia, emphasizing carbon neutrality and climate change. Students will gain the knowledge, expertise, and assurance necessary to emerge as pioneers in carbon-neutral tactics and sustainable development.

MSc Master of Science in Carbon Neutrality and Green Finance

In the global effort to address climate change, achieving carbon neutrality has become a shared goal among nations. Green finance is playing a pivotal role in enabling this transition. There is an urgent need for professionals with cross-disciplinary expertise, well-versed in both low-carbon technologies and financial instruments, given the global proliferation of carbon pricing mechanisms and the increasing scale of ESG investments.

The Master of Science in Carbon Neutrality and Green Finance program at HKUST(GZ) aims to cultivate future leaders in this field. Leveraging the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area's strengths in green finance innovation, the program brings together expertise from environmental science, energy engineering, finance, and public policy to create a comprehensive educational framework. This framework includes theoretical knowledge, practical training, and industry experience. Through a fully English-taught curriculum and a collaborative approach that bridges academia and industry, along with the "Unified HKUST, Complementary Campuses" framework, students will acquire advanced knowledge and skills in carbon neutrality and green finance, as well as insights into domestic and international carbon market policies.

A key highlight of this program is its cross-disciplinary curriculum, which integrates "Carbon Neutrality + Finance". The courses encompass critical areas including energy transition, industrial transformation, green finance, green technology and innovation, carbon accounting and management, carbon trading, and ESG investment strategies. This approach ensures that students develop a well-rounded skill set. Graduates will be well-prepared for roles in government and industry focused on carbon neutrality strategy, project development, trading, and investment, or for engaging in research and policy-making in the realms of carbon neutrality and green finance.





Financial Technology Thrust

Introduction

Financial Technology is an important emerging area that has been developing rapidly in recent years. It refers to the application of cutting-edge technologies and advanced analytics on various financial services, such as mobile banking, peer-to-peer lending, digital payments, blockchain, and cryptocurrencies, aiming to improve service efficiency, promote financial innovations, and increase end-user satisfaction.

The Master of Science in FinTech and Financial Engineering (MSc(FTFE)) at HKUST(GZ) is designed to cultivate high-level talents who possess solid financial theoretical knowledge and cutting-edge technological innovation skills, helping to address the multiple challenges of the intelligent and digital transformation of the financial industry. Students graduating from the MSc FTFE will be capable of identifying and analyzing FinTech and Financial Engineering related problems arising in financial markets, developing new quantitative models for financial data analysis, and forecasting market behavior while accounting for the inherent risks.

MSc Master of Science in Technology and Policy

The Master of Science in Technology and Policy program will provide professional training to cope with the rapid development in technology-related sectors. In many areas, public policies play a fundamental role in shaping development, application, and market. We seek to train students and equip them with cutting-edge knowledge in technology sectors and bridge the divide between industries and government.

The rigorous two-year program will provide skill-based training in the uses of analytic methods for public policy and the development of expertise in best policy practices, emulating similar programs offered by top universities in Europe and the United States. Students will acquire the knowledge, skills, and confidence to be leaders in government, business, and NGOs to shape public policies of technology, to guide and nurture technologies that change our society. By the end of this program, they will have a deeper understanding of policy, technology, and their interactive relationship in promoting social economic development.

This program cultivates future leaders by equipping students with entrepreneurial spirit, technological know-how, and policy savvy, enabling them to craft innovative policy solutions that address the challenges of technological advancement. It fosters collaboration across the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area, mainland China, and international partners in entrepreneurship education, research, and commercialization.

Urban Governance and Design Thrust

Introduction

By 2050, two out of every three people are likely to be living in cities or other urban centers, and most of the increase is expected to be highly-concentrated in a handful of countries, including China. Rapid urbanization and growth of cities call for high-quality public services and effective governance to make urban places more livable. The study of cities becomes an increasingly cross-disciplinary enterprise. Our program employs cross-disciplinary perspectives, and analyzes the data on cities from different sources (including population census, surveys, administrative and big data) to address critical issues in contemporary urban governance and design.

MPhil Master of Philosophy in Urban Governance and Design*

PhD Doctor of Philosophy in Urban Governance and Design

The MPhil Program aims to train students to conduct independent research in urban governance. An MPhil graduate is expected to acquire cross-disciplinary knowledge of cities and employ quantitative skills to integrate and analyze the data from different sources, to write research reports addressing various audience in academia, think tanks, government, or industry, and to contribute to urban governance and design in practice.

The PhD Program seeks to train students in original research with cross-disciplinary approach to urban governance and design, and to cultivate independent and innovative thinking for knowledge creation in the field. A PhD graduate is expected to demonstrate mastery of knowledge in the chosen area of research and to synthesize and create new knowledge making an original and substantial contribution to the cross-disciplinary studies of cities.

MSc Master of Science in Urban Tech and Governance*

The Master of Science in Urban Tech and Governance (MSc UTGO) at HKUST[GZ] offers a diverse training framework that extends beyond traditional urban planning. It explores emerging fields such as urban health, smart digital governance, and sustainable urban mobility while integrating innovative technologies and methodologies. This multifaceted approach equips graduates to tackle complex urban challenges, allowing them to pursue various interests and career paths. MSc UTGO graduates will be adept at identifying and analyzing urban issues, developing innovative solutions using advanced urban tech and governance methodologies, and driving urban renewal initiatives that enhance quality of life.

The UGOD Thrust at HKUST[GZ] provides well-structured internship opportunities through partnerships with leading industrial and institutional entities, including state-owned enterprises and public authorities, 70% of which are based in the Greater Bay Area. These internships align partner expertise—ranging from smart city developers to spatial data innovators—with program objectives. Graduates can assume transformative roles such as Smart City Planners, Urban Data Analysts, and Sustainability Managers. These positions span sectors like technology, urban planning, and public policy, offering diverse pathways for graduates to contribute to smart and sustainable city development. Roles such as Urban Tech Specialist and Digital Governance Specialist are particularly sought after in government agencies and related organizations.

Admission Requirements

To qualify for admissions to HKUST(GZ), applicants must meet all of the following requirements. Admission is selective and meeting these minimum requirements does not guarantee admission.

1. General Admission Requirements

For all applicants seeking postgraduate admission

- a **bachelor's degree** from a recognized institution, or an approved equivalent qualification

For PhD applicants (additional to the above)

- a proven record of outstanding performance from a recognized institution or presented evidence of satisfactory work at the postgraduate level on a full-time basis for at least one year, or on a part-time basis for at least two years

2. English Language Requirements

Fulfill the English language requirements with one of the following proficiency attainments¹:

Proficiency Test	Minimum Score
TOEFL – Internet-based Test (iBT) ²	80 (for tests taken prior to 21 January 2026) 4.5 (for tests taken from 21 January 2026 onwards)
TOEFL – Paper-based Test (pBT)	550
TOEFL – Revised Paper-delivered Test	60 (total scores for Reading, Listening and Writing sections)
IELTS (Academic Module) ²	Overall score: 6.5 and all sub-scores: 5.5

¹ You are not required to present TOEFL or IELTS score if your first language is English, or you obtained bachelor's degree (or equivalent qualification) from an institution where the medium of instruction was English.

² Refers to scores in one single attempt only. Test at home option is not accepted.
